## Makivvik's roles in the planning process: NILCA Signatory

- Participate actively in the development of planning policies, priorities, objectives and draft Land Use Plan
- Ensure NILCA principles are upheld in the process and the deliverables
- Support communities' engagement in the planning process



## **Makivvik's roles in the planning process: Owner of Nunavik Inuit Lands on behalf of Nunavik Inuit**

- Ensure that Land Use Plan is aligned with Nunavik Inuit goals & objectives for the Nunavik Inuit Lands



## Makivvik's roles in the planning process: NILCA Implementation Committee

- Liaise with NMRPC
- Ensure a Land Use Plan is delivered as per the NILCA and its Implementation Plan



## Nunavik Inuit Self-Determination as a Cornerstone

- Marine Governance: support awareness, preparedness and decision-making for shipping & other marine activities
- Devolution: transfer of control on federal lands to Nunavik Inuit
- Conservation: Inuit decision-making on establishment & management
- Climate Change: local priorities & expertise from Climate Change Adaptation Strategy
