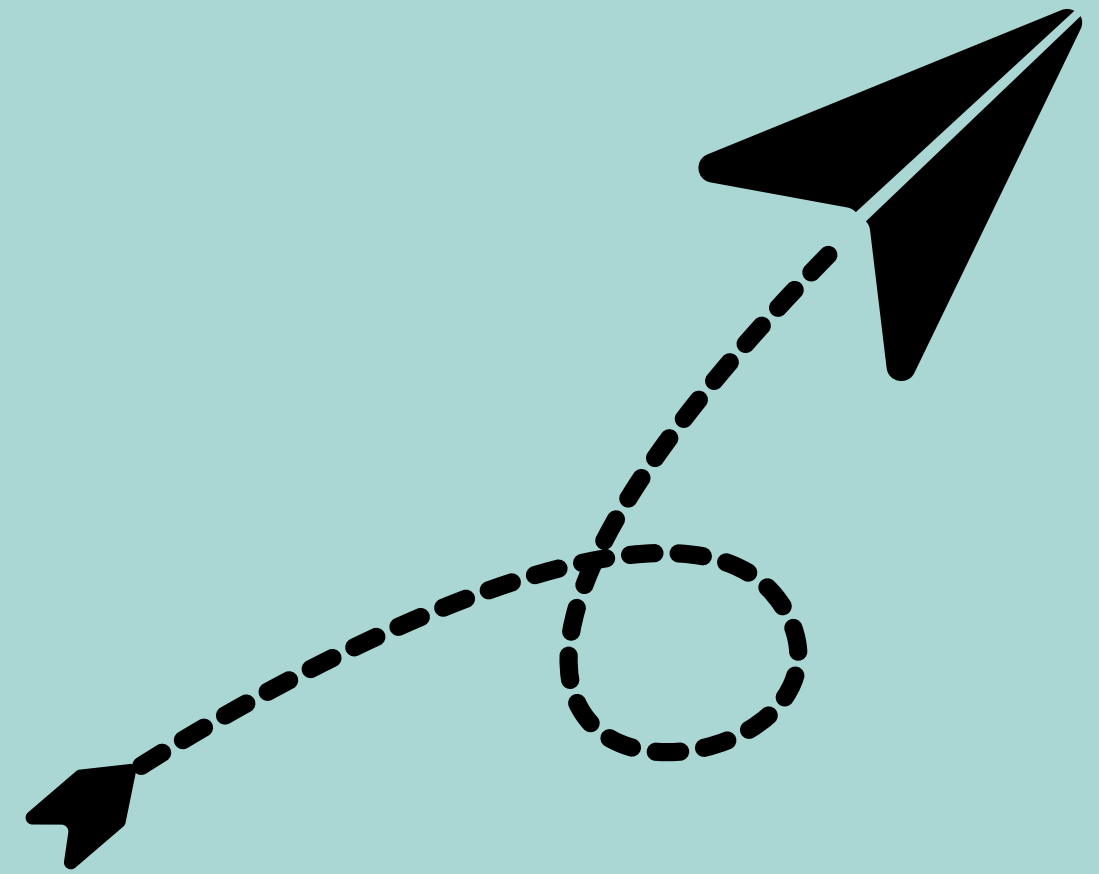

# The objectives

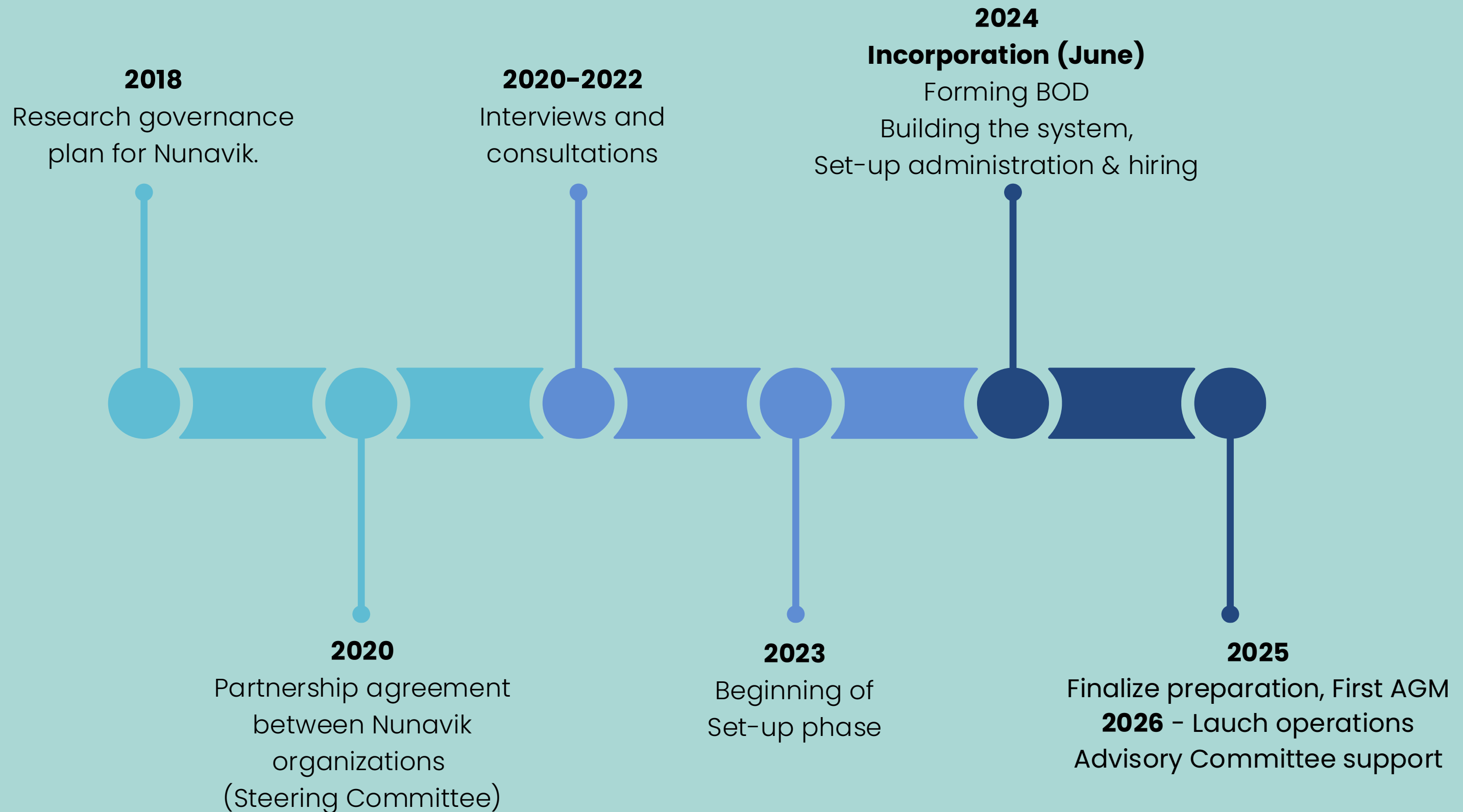
## The goals

**Seven objectives** are defined to provide specific long-term goals to direct its activities.

The organization can advance its mission by ensuring that activities are aligned with these objectives.

- 1 | Improve **regional research management**
- 2 | Improve **knowledge sharing** between organizations, communities, and researchers
- 3 | Strengthen Nunavimmiut **access to and control over** research information
- 4 | Enhance alignment of research with **Nunavik Inuit socio-cultural values** and research priorities
- 5 | Raise researchers' awareness of and adherence to **legal and ethical standards**
- 6 | Promote and support **capacity-building** and enhance training for **community-led research**
- 7 | Promote greater **socio-economic value** of research for Nunavik

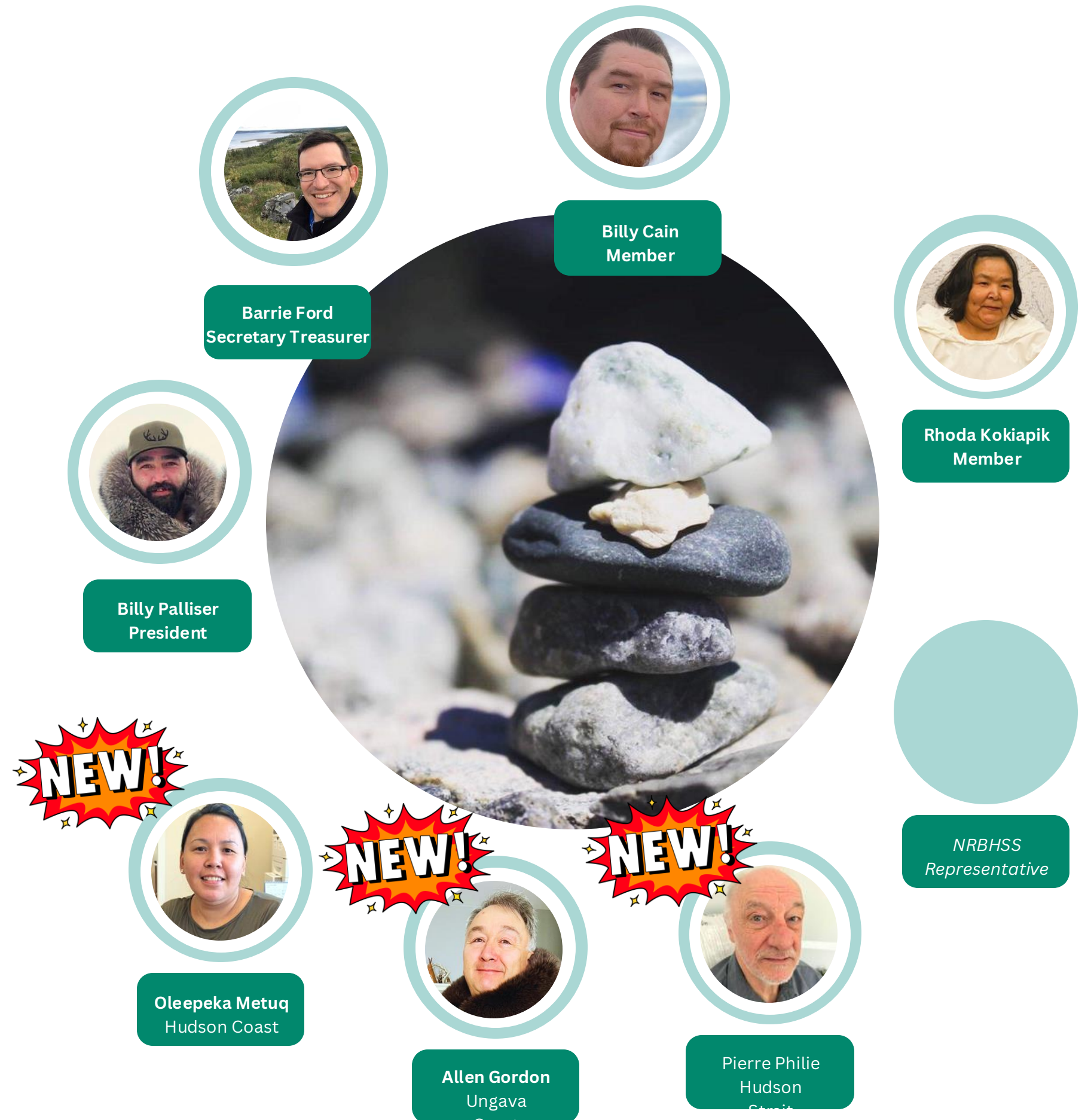
# Our Board of Directors

**In the center**

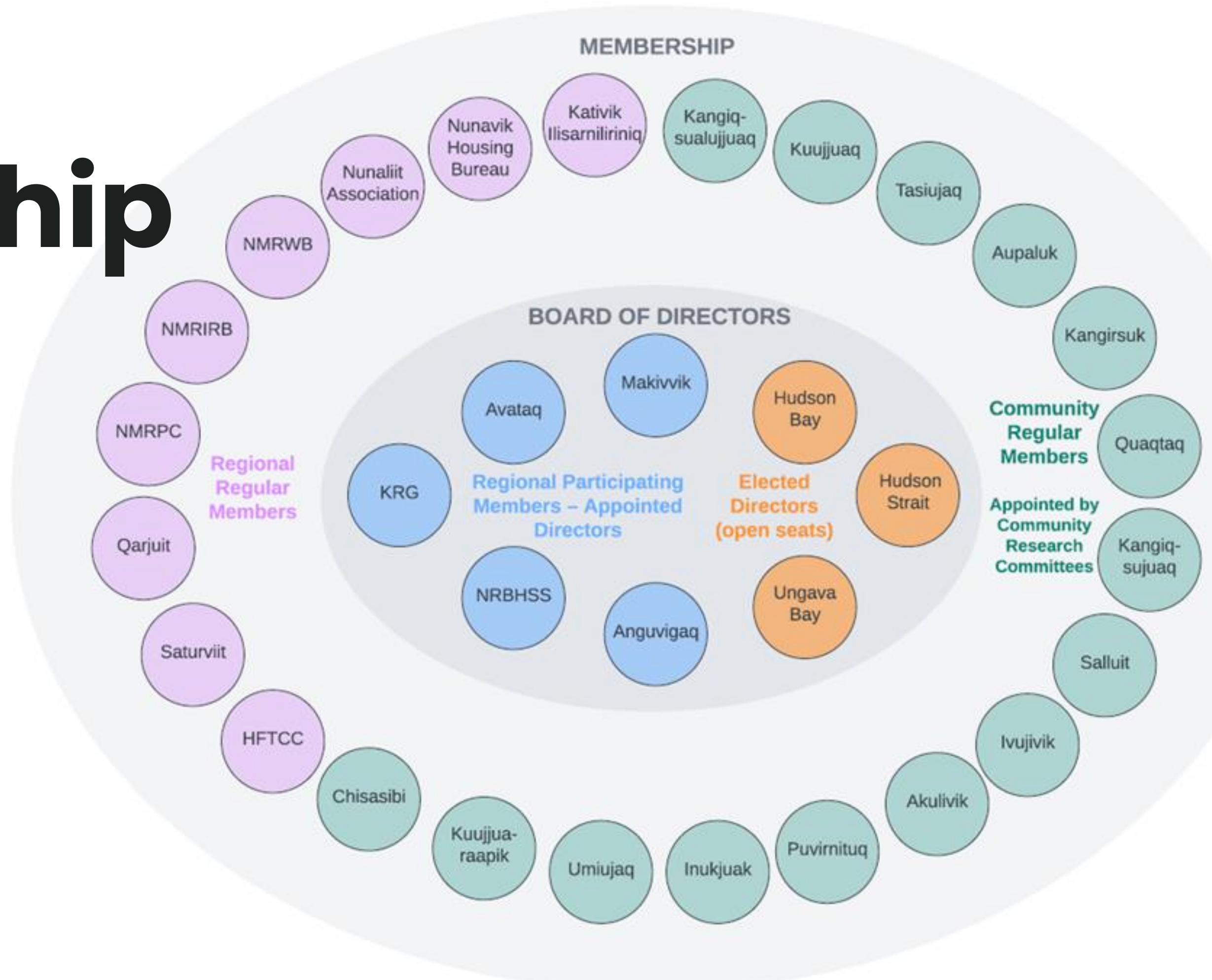
The Board of Directors is composed of the regional organizations that have a large role in research (as well as Elected Directors - which are not part of the membership)

**In Green**

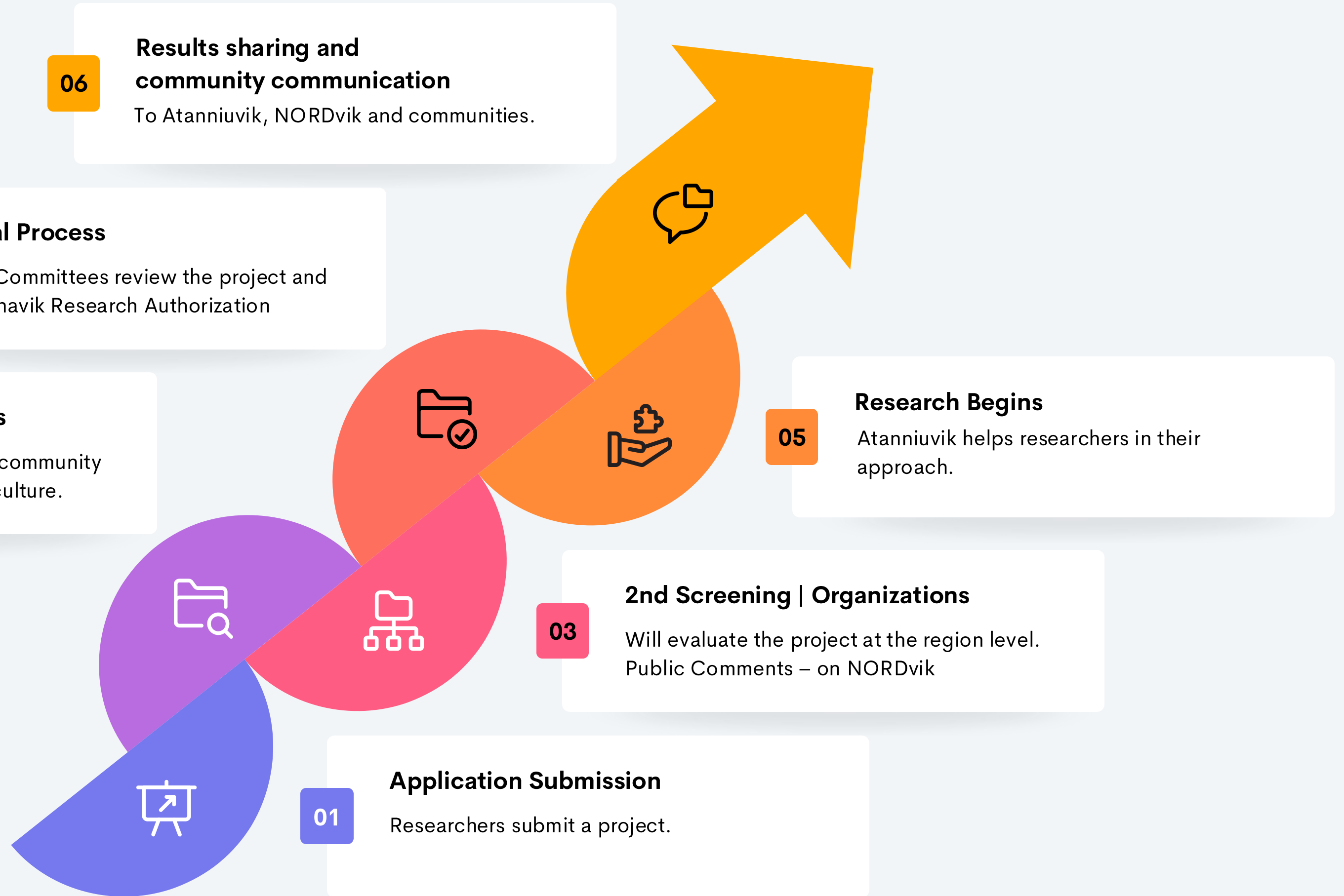

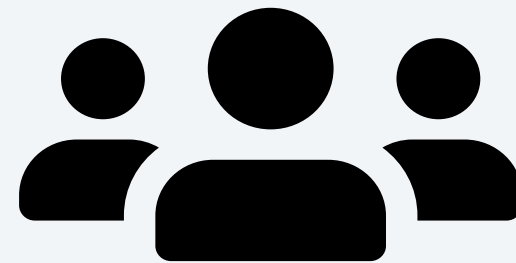

In each of the 14 Nunavik communities and for Inuit in Chisasibi.

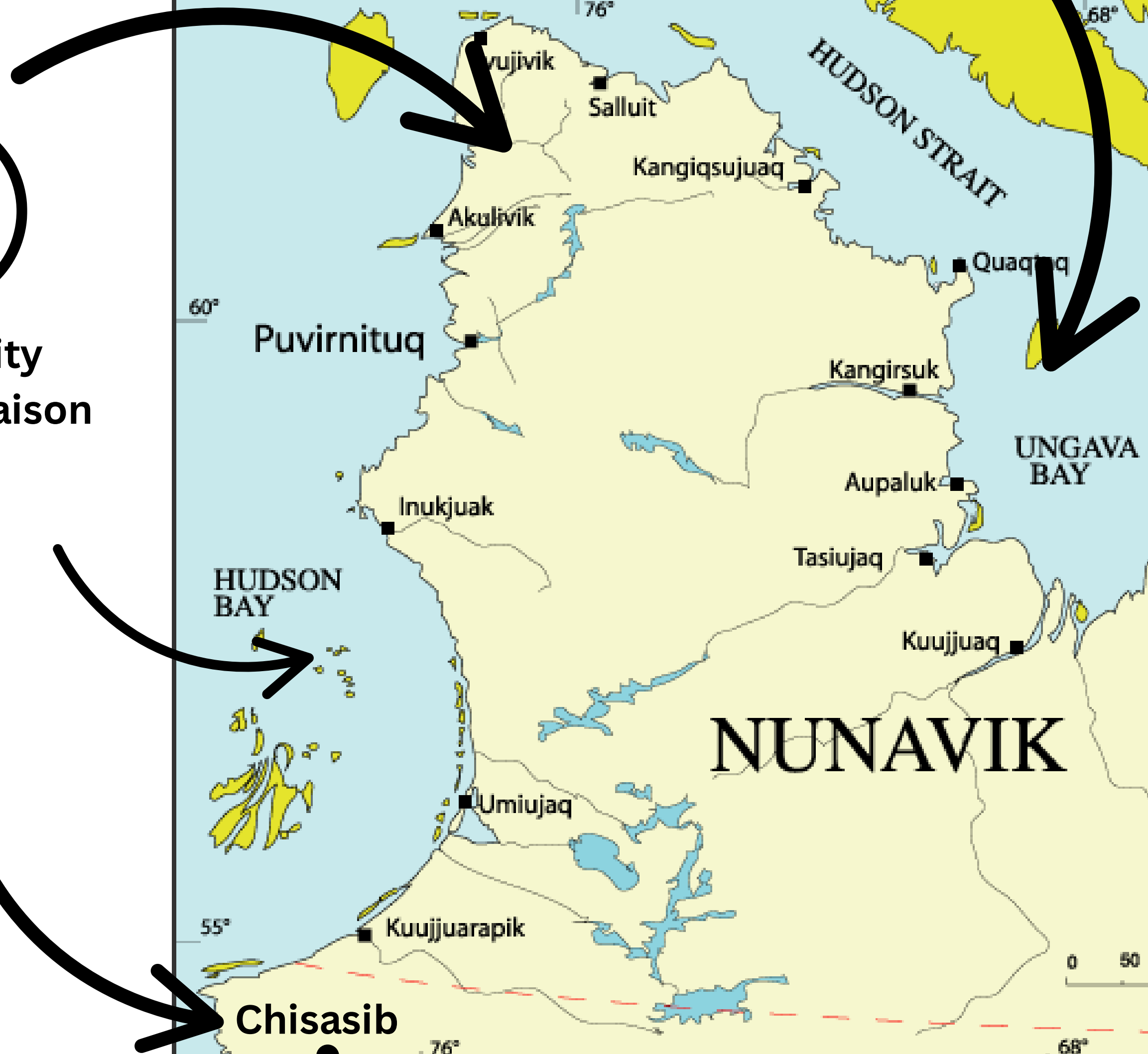
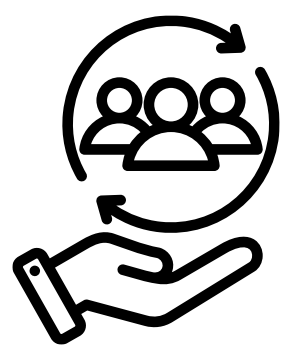
## **AT THE REGIONAL LEVEL**

## WHO?

### Which organizations ?

## 5 TO 7 MEMBERS

### Consultation

We wish to have around **5 to 7 members** in each committee.

### 3-4 / year

The committee members will be meeting **3 or 4 times a year**, depending on the research projects Atanniuvik receives concerning the community.

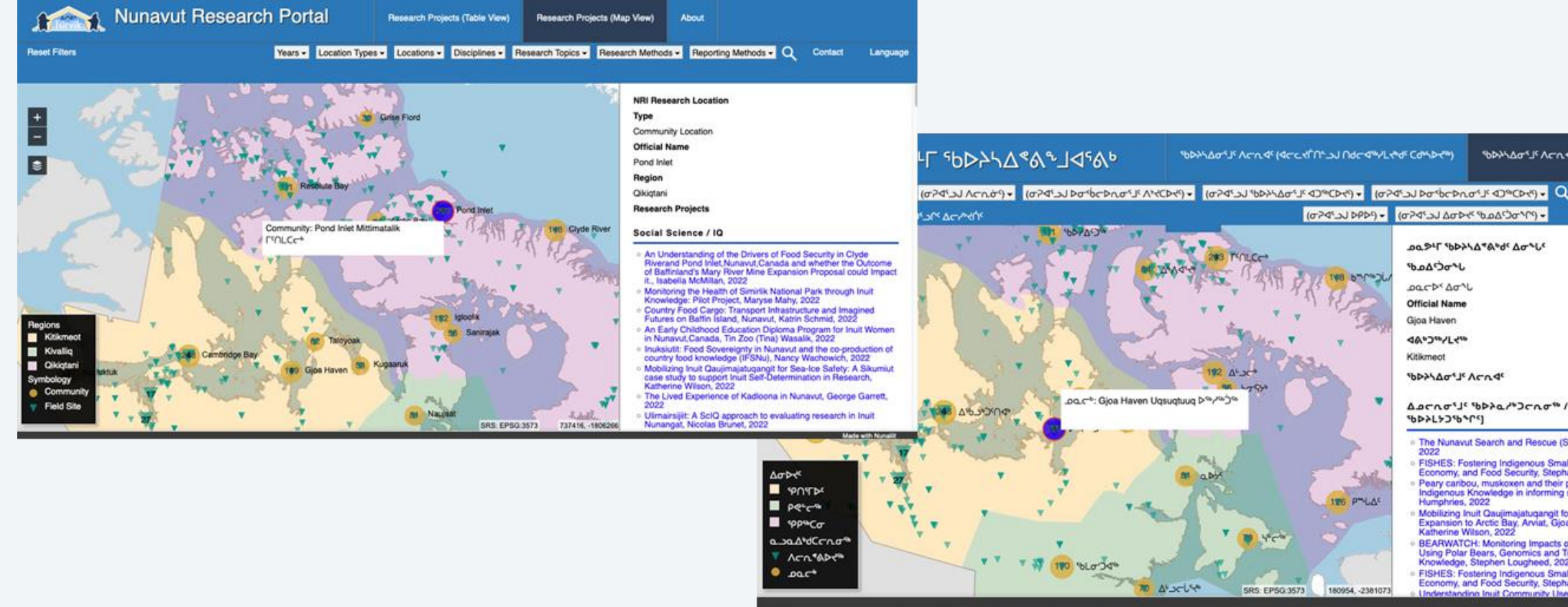


## COMMUNITY TOUR

# Atanniuvik is a...



## Research Applicant Portal

Software system,  
first stop

Provide a **portal** for **ALL** researchers to submit their projects and receive guidance.

## Research project Management Registry

System  
management

Registry to track and manage all proposed and ongoing research projects. It will be used by Atanniuvik team, review committees, and other implicated Nunavik organizations and community members to access project information.

## Atlas called NORDvik

Retrospective

Present a public **atlas illustrating research conducted in Nunavik** and map new research that are **on-going** — a platform accessible to everyone in real time. Multimedia.

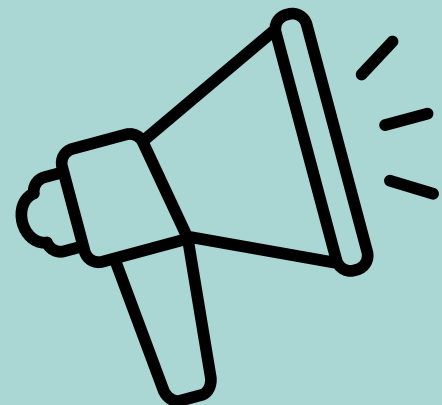
